## **Inspector General's Remarks**

Welcome to the 6<sup>th</sup> issue of the North East Lancashire District Newsletter.

As I type these comments, we have celebrated the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of VE Day and the Prime Minister has announced some relaxation of the lockdown restrictions. It seems incredible that we have endured 10 weeks of the lockdown and, with only a few exceptions, the changes in people's everyday lives seem to have been taken with good spirit.
